**Bid Procedure**

All tournaments assigned to the Northern Territory by ASA will use the following bid procedure:

1. Adult Tournaments:
  - a. Adult Tournament Bids must be submitted on the ASA Official Bid Form to the National Office on or before July 1 of the current year.
  - b. Bids will be awarded at the Northern Territory Meeting held in conjunction with the Annual ASA Council Meeting. **Note:** Change in procedure for all Territories effective 2009: Adult Territory Tournaments will be awarded as part of the Tournament Bid Process using the voting machines.
  
2. Junior Olympic (Youth) Tournaments:
  - a. ASA Regions within the Northern Territory will submit bids on the ASA Official Bid Form to the National Office on or before July 1 of the current year for those tournaments that are allocated to a region by the Northern Territory Rotation. (See above grid.)
  - b. Each region will select one bid to be approved at the Territory Meeting held in conjunction with the Annual ASA Council Meeting.
  - c. Bid Requirements (Junior Olympic Tournaments Only):
    1. **Entry Fee: \$400.00 (maximum effective for 2011 tournaments)**
    2. Minimum Bid Fee: \$200.00 Per Team (The minimum bid fee includes the \$100.00 per team ASA assessment fee.)
  - d. Any tournaments without a proper bid in accordance with the Territory Rotation will be open to rebid to all Regions within the Northern Territory.

**Tournament Length**

1. Junior Olympic (Youth) Tournaments:
  - a. Girls' Junior Olympic (youth) tournaments will start no earlier than Thursday and end on Sunday unless circumstances warrant an earlier start date. In the event a city would need to start the tournament earlier than Thursday, they must make a request to the Territory Vice Presidents through their Region Director.
